## walk...IN FARNLEY

### The Tour walk

- 1 Enter School Wood through the kissing gate and follow the top path.
- 2 Turn right onto Brockholes Road and right again onto the track and follow the signed paths.
- 3 At the viewpoint seat take the left path down through the field, which brings you out onto Hall Ing Road.
- 4 Turn left and walk up the road.
- 5 Take the footpath on the right, opposite the red telephone box.
- 6 Turn right and follow the sign to Marry Carry.
- 7 Take the footpath on the left which winds through the wood and runs alongside the railway line.
- 8 Once through the underpass, bear left and take the footpath over the style.
- 9 Turn right and follow the road down to Gyn Lane.
- 10 Turn left towards the main New Mill road and Honley, or turn right to continue the circular walk.
- 11 Take the left hand path.
- 12 Turn right up the hill and follow the signs.

**Distance:** approx. 4 miles

**Time:** approx. 2 hours

#### Terrain

Paths can become muddy and slippery during wet weather. Suitable clothing and sturdy footwear is advised. Some parts of the route are steep and might be unsuitable for individuals with limited mobility.

#### Keep our countryside safe

Many diseases and harmful weeds that can have a devastating effect on the Estate's flora and fauna, including foot and mouth, ash dieback, and Himalayan balsam, can unwittingly be carried onto the land by vehicles, people, horses and pets.

#### **P** Permissive paths
